The role is based within the kitchen units of each of our purpose-built bungalows for older people with dementia. Hospitality Support Workers prepare meals and drinks for residents and their visitors. They maintain the homely environment by ensuring there are magazines and books put out, playing CDs, watering plants, laying tables etc. They assist in housework, help at meal-times and keep the kitchen clean and well stocked.
